## THE GOSPEL OF SALVATION DOES NOT CHANGE IT WAS PREACHED TO THOSE LIVING BEFORE CHRIST IN THE TIMES OF THE HEBREW SCRIPTURES

- 1. The Gospel "By which we are saved" is "according to the " (Hebrew) <u>Scriptures"</u>—I Cor. 15:1-5.
- 2. "The (Hebrew) <u>Scriptures</u> are able to make one wise unto salvation, through faith which is in Jesus Christ"— II Tim. 3:15.
- 3. The gospel was preached by <u>all the prophets</u>—''To Him (Christ) give ALL THE PROPHETS WITNESS that everyone believing in Him will receive remission of sins''—Acts 10:43.
- 4. The gospel was preached to those of Noah's day—"When the patience of God waited...For this reason was the gospel preached also to those...a preacher of righteousness... the righteousness which is by faith"—I Pet. 3:19,20; 4:6; II Pet. 2:5 & Heb. 11:7.
- 5. "The Gospel was preached to Abraham"—Gal. 3:8 & Rom. 4:1-5.
- 6. The gospel was preached to <u>Israel in the wilderness</u>—
  "The gospel was presented to us EVEN AS TO THEM
  ALSO (Israel of old)"—Heb. 3:17-4:2.
- 7. The gospel was preached to those <u>of Isaiah's time</u>—"But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, 'LORD, who has believed our report?""—Rom. 10:16 & Isa. 53:1.
- 8. The gospel was preached to those <u>of David's day</u>—"Even as David also describes the blessedness of the man to whom God imputes righteousness apart from works...'whose sins are covered'..."—Rom. 4:6-8 & Psalm 32:1,2.
- 9. The gospel has <u>always been taught in the physical creation</u>—
  "But I say, have they not heard (obeyed) the gospel? Yes indeed: 'Their sound has gone out to all the earth, and their words to the end of the world'" Rom. 10:16,18; Psalm 19:4 & Rom. 1:18-20.
- 10. The gospel is "THE EVERLASTING GOSPEL"—Rev. 14:6
