- 1. "Look unto Me and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth, for I am God, and there is none else"—Isaiah 45:22.
- 2. "The Lord has made known His salvation: His righteousness has He openly revealed in the sight of the heathen...all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God"—Psalm 98:2,3.
- 3. "The Lord is near to them that are of a broken heart; and saves such as be of a contrite spirit"—Psalm 34:18.
- 4. "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord does not impute iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile...I acknowledged my sin to Thee...and You forgave the iniquity of my sin"—Psalm 32:1-5
- 5. "I have blotted out as a thick cloud, your sins; return to Me; for I have redeemed you'—Isaiah 44:22.
- 6. "As far as the East is from the West, so far has He removed our transgressions from us"—Psalm 103:12.
- 7. "You have in love to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for You have cast all my sins behind Your back"—
  Isaiah 38:17
- 8. "A broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise"—Psalm 51:16,17.
- 9. "You have forgiven the iniquity of Your people, You have covered all their sin"—Psalm 85:2.
